NOTICE OF ELECTION ON TAX LEVY IN EXCESS OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION ROOTSTOWN LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of resolutions of the Board of Education of the Rootstown Local School District, Ohio passed on January 10, 2022 and January 24, 2022, there will be submitted to a vote of the people of the Rootstown Local School District at a Primary Election to be held at the regular places of voting on Tuesday, May 3, 2022, the question of a renewal of two tax levies in the sum of \$1,145,000 per year for a period of ten years for the purpose of providing for the emergency requirements of the School District.

The estimated tax outside of the ten-mill limitation necessary to raise that annual amount as certified by the county auditor is to average 4.5 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 45 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for ten years, commencing in 2022, first due in calendar year 2023. If approved, any remaining tax years on any of the two existing levies will not be collected after 2022.

The polls for said election will be open at 6:30 a.m., and will remain open until 7:30 p.m. on Election Day.
