

**NOTICE OF ELECTION ON BOND AND TAX LEVY
IN EXCESS OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION
ROOTSTOWN LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT**

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of Resolution No. 2019-07-182 of the Board of Education of the Rootstown Local School District, Ohio adopted on July 29, 2019, there will be submitted to the electors of said school district at a General Election to be held in the school district at the regular places of voting therein, on Tuesday, November 7, 2017, the questions of the issuing of bonds for the benefit of said school district for the purpose of constructing, furnishing and equipping a new PreK-8 school building and otherwise improving school district buildings and facilities and clearing, improving and equipping their sites and imposing an additional tax levy for general permanent improvements.

The principle amount of the bond is \$22,830,000, to be repaid annually over a maximum period of 37 years, and an annual levy of property taxes be made outside the ten-mill limitation of 4.95 mills at a rate not exceeding 4.95 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 49.5 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, commencing in 2019, first due in calendar year 2020, to pay the annual debt charges on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds. An additional property tax levy to be made outside the ten-mill limitation of 0.5 mill at a rate not exceeding 0.5 mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 5 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation for a continuing period of time.

The polls for the election will be open at 6:30 a.m. will remain open until 7:30 p.m. on Election Day.
