There were 255 deaths reported to the coroner. Of those reported, 132 cases were eventually referred to an attending physician because they did not meet the definition of a coroner case. Of those 132 death referrals, 16 required on-the-scene investigation before a determination could be rendered. One Hundred Twenty-three (123) cases became coroner cases as defined by the Ohio Revised Code.
