Guardianship of Incompetent Adult Instructions

Requirements

The alleged incompetent adult must be a current resident of Portage County, Ohio. At the hearing on the application for appointment of guardian, the applicant bears the burden of proving, by clear and convincing evidence of both of the following: (1) the ward's mental incompetence; and (2) that no less restrictive alternative exists to the proposed guardianship (Portage County Local Rule 66.3(B)).
