PRESENTATION OF PROCLAMATION TO UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS

INTERNAL SERVICES

Present: Director Shannon Kautzman

Discussion:

1. Project Updates

Commissioner Tinlin stated that he enjoys reading the Project Updates that Director Kautzman presents, and he likes the format that she uses for the spreadsheet.

Director Kautzman says that she has only a couple of project updates since Thursday. The concrete at the overflow lot was in the process of being poured. This concrete will be the new site for the mailboxes, which will be bolted down with bollards placed around them for protection. Bollards will also be placed around the down spouts at the maintenance building. The company is estimating that the asphalt will be completed next week; weather permitting. Director Kautzman brought attention to the removal of the guardrails in front of the Administration Building, as well.

Unfortunately, the company performing the work at the Prosecutor's Office is unable to use the originally planned method of swing-stage scaffold for the east side of the building. There are unforeseen issues with the scaffolding method as it was originally thought that steel beams could be placed on the roof of the building to bear the weight load. The engineering firm recently determined that it would not be safe, and it is their recommendation that work is not performed using this method. Work has been completed in the past by using the roof, but it was not sanctioned. Specified scaffolding must be built for the project and rented for a month for an additional cost of \$35,000. The scaffolding would then be torn down.

The Commissioners expressed shock and frustration with the amount. They feel it is excessive.

Director Kautzman agreed and stated that the cost reflects it being a labor-intensive project. Scaffolding would be needed on the south and east sides of the building, due to the space between the buildings being extremely narrow. She is waiting for a second quote from the company doing the work, but states that the project is at a standstill until one of the given quotes is approved. A change order will also need to be completed. Director Kautzman reached out to Director Jackie Petty to discuss the predicament. It was concluded that NOPEC funds could be used to cover the additional cost of the scaffolding or to relieve some of the money that has already been spent, freeing up funds.

Commissioner Badalamenti asked what Director Kautzman needed from the Board. She stated that if she does not receive a quote that is lesser than the one already given, she would like permission to proceed with the renting of the scaffolding, so the project can be finished.

Commissioner Christian-Bennett stated that there is really no choice in the matter, and the work seems to be ongoing. Director Kautzman stated that the work needed was on the second and third floor. The exterior layer was removed from the building, exposing the foam which was not caulked correctly. The windows were not snapped into place the correct way, leaving exposure to the elements.

Commissioner Badalamenti asked when the leaking originally started. Director Kautzman stated that it was shortly after the work was completed. The county attempted to find the original company negligent.

Prosecutor Christopher Meduri was present, so he was asked what year the Prosecutor's office moved to the location. Prosecutor Meduri stated that the office moved to the location in 2008 and the leaking has been occurring for quite a while.

The Commissioners reluctantly agree to the proceedings and hope that the second quote is less.

Commissioner Badalamenti asked if there are windows on the back side of the building and was told that the main leak was from that side. The water would pour through certain windows. This side of the building is where Assistant Prosecutor Meduri's office is located. He has a view of the bank drive-thru.

At the Records Center, Director Kautzman verifies that the concrete was poured, and it looks great. It is estimated that the asphalt will be completed next week, due to weather conditions, as the company is attempting to finish up other projects as well. Commissioner Tinlin stated that he went to the Records Center to examine the bathrooms that were installed and noticed that the building needs power washed. He asked Director Kautzman if that could be completed.

PROSECUTORS OFFICE

Assistant Prosecutor, Christopher Meduri explained that he is bringing forward a Resolution where the Board would declare parcels in Streetsboro not needed for use by the County. This matter is regarding land parcels that were donated by Portage County to the City of Streetsboro in 2018. The transactions were never recorded, and the City of Streetsboro is in the process of starting projects that require consolidating the parcels. Once this Resolution is

passed, a new agreement will be sent to Streetsboro authorities. It was felt best to forego the agreement from 2018 and adopt a new ordinance. Once it is adopted, the agreement will be brought to the Board by Mr. Meduri where it can be completed.

1. The Board of Commissioners declare certain real property owned by the Portage County Board of Commissioners situated in the City of Streetsboro as not needed for public use and to proceed to negotiate a conveyance agreement with the City of Streetsboro pursuant to ORC 307.10(b)./Resolution No. 23-0489

Since Mr. Meduri is present with the Commissioners, Commissioner Badalamenti would like an update on the proceedings with the Airport.

Prosecutor Meduri states that he plans on being at the following meeting with several actions. AMS Title Services just sent the title work and legal descriptions the day before to the Prosecutor's Office. He asked the company to provide an Auditor's value in the event the Board wanted to proceed with a title commitment and insurance. Going from memory, Mr. Meduri says the Auditor's value is over \$3 million for all the combined parcels. Amy, from AMS Title gave a ballpark figure of around \$11,000 for the title insurance.

Commissioner Christian-Bennett states that the purchase price is not going to be that amount, though. Prosecutor Meduri had the company figure the cost with the Auditor's value because there is no actual fair market value.

Commissioner Badalamenti verified that it would be a one-time fee of \$11,000. Commissioner Christian-Bennett asked if that was just for the conveyance, and if there is an exemption since the property was once the County's in the first place. Mr. Meduri states that there is an exemption with the transfer tax, but the \$11,000 is for title commitment and title insurance based upon a percentage value of the transfer.

Commissioner Tinlin asked if the insurance is really needed, and he doesn't personally feel that it is. Commissioner Christian-Bennett agrees that if the search is completed and no liens are found, then there is no need to spend 11 grand. Mr. Meduri states that is fair, and since the transaction is with another public entity, if the Commissioners feel comfortable, they can forego the insurance.

The Commissioners agree that it is not needed.
