1. Comparison of Commissioners' Turnover Report.

Director Kovick presented the Turnover report for January-September 2020 last week and this week, she's brought back last year's numbers for comparison.

The turnover increased slightly from 7.10% to 10.09%. The voluntary terminations this year included 30 and last year during the same time period they were 21.

The work/life category was also the highest in 2019 and compared to this year, and there was an increase of employees resigning due to work hours and relocation.

Commissioner Christian-Bennett asked if the resignations are coming from a specific department and Director Kovick noted there were 2 employees from Water Resources, 1 from Job and Family Services and 1 from Solid Waste Management District.
