Mrs. Smith will include the bid locations in the next set of awards. She then reviewed the status of the WPCLF Program. With these approved systems, we are around \$240,000 of the \$300,000 award amount in 2016. Other locations being investigated would bring the total to just over \$300,000. All 2016 award amounts need to be encumbered by November 3, 2017. These systems are located in communities throughout the County.

In was the consensus of the Board that Mrs. Smith apply for the 2018 Water Pollution Control Loan Fund in the amount of \$200,000.

E. Board Support for NACCHO Accreditation Grant – Mr. Diorio informed the Board of a \$15,000 Grant available from the National Association of City and County Health Officials (NACCHO) to help defray expenses for the Accreditation Application process. Even though there is a very limited number of grant awards, we would still like to apply. In the Grant Application, there is a section to indicate your Board support. The fee to apply for Accreditation is estimated around \$50,000. We hope to start the Accreditation Application process at the end of this year or early 2018. Board Member Howard presented a motion for the Board to Support the Application of the \$15,000 NACCHO Grant for Accreditation Application Expenses, seconded by Board Member Hammar. An "aye" vote was cast by all, motion carried.
