This program is an opportunity for the public to leave a lasting environmental gift in honor or memory of someone special or for themselves. Our children, grandchildren and future generations will reap the benefits these planted trees offer as they grow and flourish on conserved land.

Each gift of \$50 offsets the cost of planting and long-term stewardship of one tree in a **Portage Park District** park. Our experienced staff will determine the appropriate native tree species to be planted to maximize ecological benefits and success.

The gift of a tree planted in **Portage Parks** is a great way to celebrate or honor any occasion. Honor a special birthday, graduation, anniversary, or retirement by planting a tree. This opportunity can also be a great option for memorial gifts in lieu of flowers for a loved one or pet.



Why Forests Matter:

- Forests protect clean water that supports life in all forms. Forests shade and cool our streams, reduce flooding, reduce erosion, and filter sediment to improve water quality.
- Reforesting with a variety of native species makes our forest communities healthier and more resilient.
- Forests provide critical habitat for a variety of native plants and animals, some that only live in large, mature forests.
- Without our help, it can take 150 years for a forest to develop on open land, while an established forest can be removed almost overnight. Active reforestation helps to mitigate such rapid changes.
- Forests improve air quality and help offset our pollution.
- Planted trees become native seed sources that contribute to increased biodiversity and continued forest regeneration.
- Forests are beautiful places to experience peace, renewal and recreation that contribute to our mental and physical health.

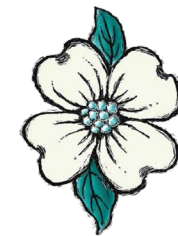
