Nutrizone Expands Recall of Various Lots of Multiple Dietary Supplements Because of Possible Salmonella Health Risk

NutriZone, LLC of Houston, Texas is updating an incorrectly reported lot number provided in an earlier press release. Previously, NutriZone indicated the Paint Out Maeng Da lot number was 10957. The correct lot number is 10959. Consumers who have purchased the products should verify the lot number.

The recall of dietary supplements is due to the potential for contamination with *Salmonella*. *Salmonella*, is an organism which can cause serious and sometimes fatal infections in young children, frail or elderly people, and others with weakened immune systems.

Healthy people infected with *Salmonella* should monitor themselves for some or all of the following symptoms: nausea, vomiting, diarrhea or bloody diarrhea, abdominal cramping and fever.

Rarely, Salmonella can result in more serious ailments, including arterial infections, endocarditis, arthritis, muscle pain, eye irritation, and urinary tract symptoms. Consumers exhibiting these signs after having contact with this product should contact their healthcare providers.

The dietary supplements are labeled and packaged as follows:

The products were sold in Pennsylvania, Oklahoma, Washington, Missouri, Florida, Mississippi, California and Texas.

No illnesses have been reported to date in connection with this problem.

The potential for contamination was noted after routine sampling and testing by the FDA revealed the presence of *Salmonella*.
