Resolution # 22-91 Revising the Public Swimming Pool and Spa Fees to Comply with Ohio Revised Code 3749 and Administrative Code Chapter 3701-31 October 18, 2022 3rd Reading Fees to be Effective December 1, 2022

RESOLUTION

BY: THE PORTAGE COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH OF THE PORTAGE COUNTY COMBINED GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT

RE: REVISING THE PUBLIC SWIMMING POOL AND SPA FEES TO COMPLY WITH OHIO REVISED CODE 3749 AND OHIO ADMINISTRATIVE CODE CHAPTER 3701-31. FEES TO BE EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 1, 2022.

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Portage County Combined General Health District is desirous of preventing disease and maintaining the integrity of the health, safety and morals of the citizens of the Portage County Combined General Health District;

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Portage County Combined General Health District is desirous of performing its duties in regard to administering, licensing and inspecting the public swimming pool and spa program as required;

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code 3749.04 states that each licensor administering and enforcing section 3749 of the Ohio Revised Code and the rules adopted thereunder may establish licensing and inspection fees in accordance with section 3709.09 of the Ohio Revised Code, which shall not exceed the cost of licensing and inspecting public swimming pools and public spas;

WHEREAS, section 3701-36-14 of the Ohio Administrative Code establishes a cost methodology for boards of health to calculate costs of providing services specified in section 3749.04;

WHEREAS, Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3701-31-03 instructs the licensor to utilize a cost methodology to calculate fees not to exceed the cost of licensing and inspection of public swimming pools and spas;

WHEREAS, Ohio Administrative Code 3701-31-03 establishes license fee categories in accordance with the following categories: individual public swimming pools, individual public spas, individual special use pools, additional licenses located at the same address and government/tax supported schools;

WHEREAS, due to the results of required cost methodologies it is necessary to revise the associated fees to cover the costs to institute and administer the Pool and Spa Program; and

RESOLUTION

Section 1. WHEREFORE, the following fees shall be adopted in accordance with Section 3709.09 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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2023 PROPOSED FEE SCHEDULE


3701-31-03(D) states in part "License fee established by a licensor pursuant to section 3709.09 of the Revised Code for a public swimming pool shall be specified in accordance with the following categories:

Individual public swimming pools; Individual public spas; and

(3) Individual special use pools.
(4) Individual and Additional licenses. Each individual public swimming pool shall be issued an individual license based on the categories listed above. Facilities where multiple public swimming pools are located at the same address, the licensor MAY establish a reduced fee for each additional

license. (5) Government/tax supported schools. For public swimming pools which are operated by the federal government, the state government, or a county, city, township, village, or tax-supported primary or secondary public school, the board of health of a city or general health district <u>MAY</u> adopt fees that are less than the fees established under paragraphs (D)(1) - (D)(3) of this rule.

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
