Park District Awarded \$1.5 Million in Grants for Headwaters Trail

In 2023, the Park District acquired two important sections of the former railroad corridor in Mantua Township at each end of land already owned by the Park District. The western end is a ~2,400-foot trail lease from First Energy Corporation who had purchased the corridor earlier from Norfolk Southern Railway. Read more...
