Planning a fun and safe visit

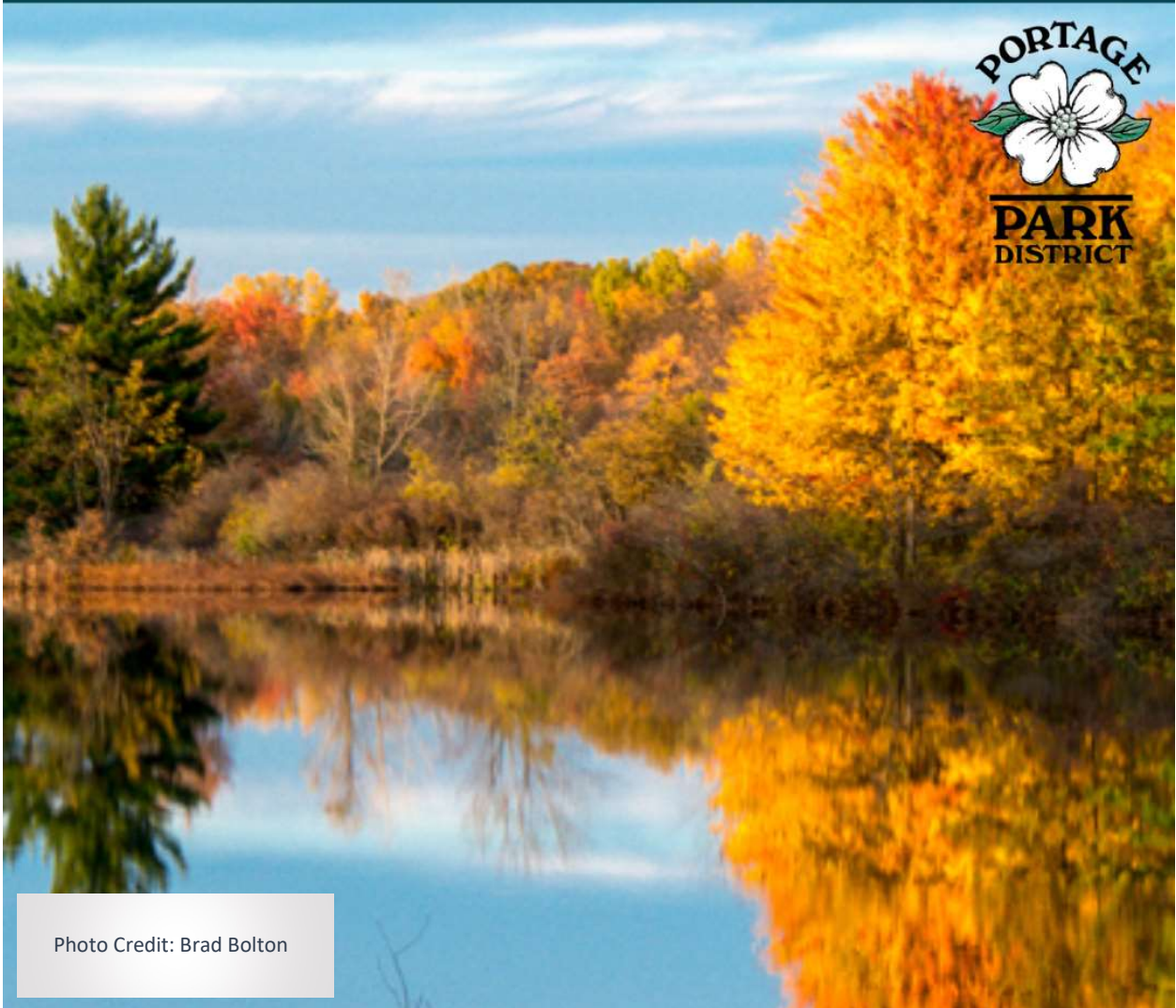

My visit to TRAIL LAKE PARK.

A preview for an enjoyable visit.



I will know I am there when I see the TRAIL LAKE PARK SIGN.



In the PARKING LOT I will stay close to the adult or group I came with to be safe.



There is a RESTROOM near the
PARKING LOT.

(The toilet does not flush and there is not
running water. I can use hand sanitizer to wash
my hands.)



The KIOSK is where I will find a MAP and other information.



Before I HIKE, I may want comfortable WALKING SHOES, WATER, SUNSCREEN, and INSECT REPELLENT.



SIGN POSTS help me follow the trail I want to HIKE. The OSPREY LOOP is marked with an OSPREY image.



The OSPREY LOOP is a 1.62 mile trail that is ADA accessible and asphalt paved.



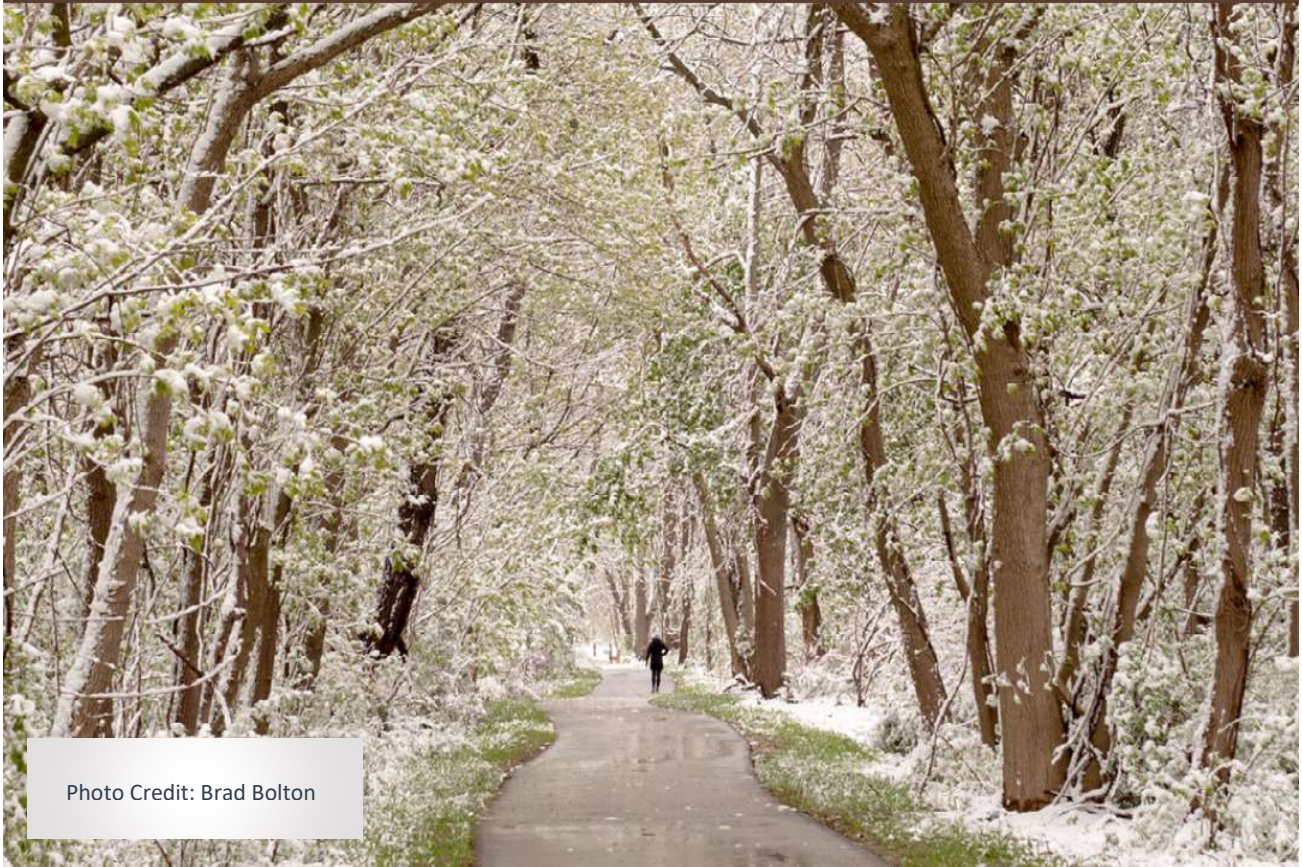
If I choose to, I can walk onto the
PIER for a closer look at the LAKE, to
use my FISHING POLE, or to use the
KAYAK/CANOE LAUNCH.



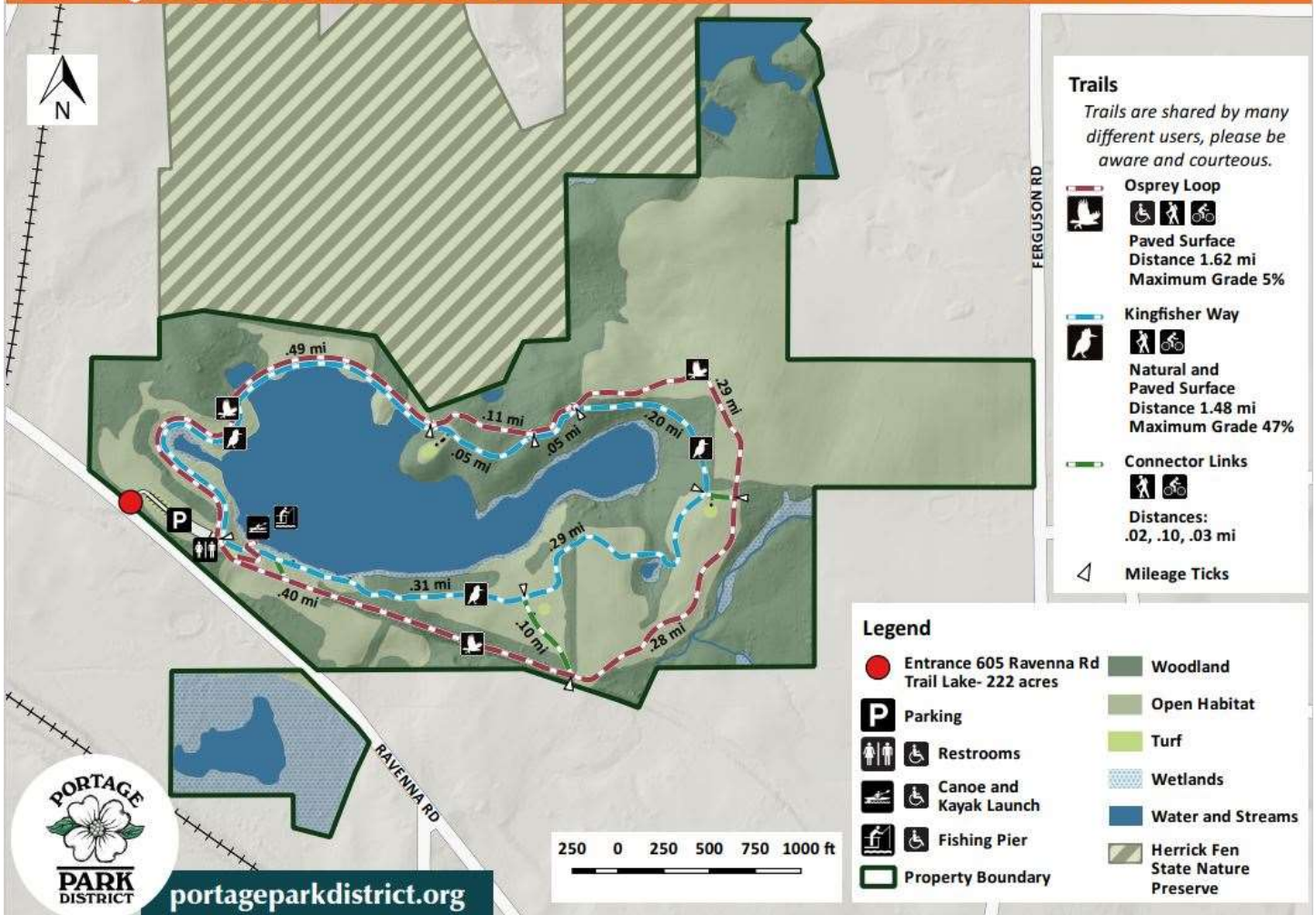
I can bring my own KAYAK or CANOE and use the ACCESSIBLE LAUNCH to enjoy the lake.



There are other FISHING SPOTS around the lake on the KINGFISHER WAY TRAIL. I can check the FISHING MAP for these locations.



When the weather is COLD, I can still visit the park if I dress WARM. Dressing for the weather lets me visit in all SEASONS: WINTER, SPRING, SUMMER, and FALL.



There are other TRAILS that I may choose to HIKE. These trails are part NATURAL SURFACE and can be muddy if it has rained.
