

Fewer than 1/3 of US adults have a bachelor's degree or higher, the requirement for more than half of today's well paying jobs




Percentage of "good jobs" — \$17/hour under age 45, \$22/hour above — by educational attainment level

The Economic Benefit of Higher Education Jumps When You Finish a Bachelor's Degree






